CHORAL BURSARIES – 2010

The Lucian Singers through the Parish of Christ Church St Lucia are offering 4 Choral Bursaries for 2010. The Bursary holders will be expected to sing with the Lucian Singers for the period of the Bursary (i.e. 12 months from commencement). The following conditions apply:

- Bursary holders will be required to sing the following Services or arrange a suitable substitute.

1. Maundy Thursday 7.30pm
2. Good Friday 12.00pm – 3.00pm
3. Easter Day 5.00am – 9.00am
4. Feast of Christ the King – morning Eucharist
5. Advent Recital
6. Christmas Carol Service
7. Christmas Eve Midnight Mass

As well as

- At least 80% of the regular morning Eucharists as required of the Lucian Singers (Sunday 8.15am – 12.00pm)
- and
- Other special occasions as negotiated with the Director of Music

In return, the Bursary holder will receive:

- \$1500 payable in 2 equal instalments (\$750 for six months).
- Opportunity to experience the traditional choral work of the English and Continental sacred traditions
- Opportunity to sing and gain significant choral experience under the leadership of a recognized choral director

The Bursaries are for a period of 1 year and are not renewable. There is provision to offer a bursary for 6 months, at the rate of \$750.

About the Lucian Singers

The Lucian Singers is the liturgical choir of the Anglican Parish of Christ Church St Lucia. Since its formation in over thirty years ago this choir has contributed to the worship life of the Parish by singing at the regular worship services of that church. Under the leadership of Graeme Morton, the choir sings at the weekly 9.00am Sunday Eucharist as well as the major Feast Days of the Christian Year. In addition, the choir gives regular recital programmes, is invited to perform at St John's Cathedral services on occasions throughout the year and participates in the Parish life by organising activities of a social and musical nature in which the Parish as a whole can participate. The choir currently has a membership of about thirty-five singers.

The music performed reflects the traditional sacred music of the English and Continental traditions from the Renaissance to the current day, giving a wide and varied nature to the music performed.
